Dr Ingram is an active member of several Australasian, American and other International professional bodies including plastic surgery, aesthetic plastic surgery, hand surgery and head and neck surgery societies. A current board member and past President of the Australasian Society of Aesthetic Plastic Surgeons (ASAPS), Dr Ingram is also a regular faculty member for the Melbourne Advanced Facial Anatomy Course (MAFAC), teaching facial aesthetic surgery techniques to other specialists in Australia and overseas.
